# Voluntary Payroll Deduction Program

State employees may elect to have employee association dues, contributions to employee association foundations, payments to credit unions, banks, or savings associations having an office in this state, contributions to the College Savings Plan, supplemental insurance and retirement plan premiums, and subscription fees to Oklahoma Today Magazine automatically deducted from their paychecks. This is made possible through the State's **Voluntary Payroll Deduction Program**.

Material from some of the vendors involved in this program is included in this booklet. None of the vendors in the program are under contract with the State through the Employees Benefits Council (Council).

Vendors involved in the program must meet other requirements of Oklahoma law to participate. In addition, the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) has administrative rules to implement the program. OPM also maintains a comprehensive list of organizations approved for payroll deductions through the program.
